
Editor's Corner








Purpose - By teaching a dog to go long past short bumpers, we 'improve the ability of the dog to focus where you direct and then go where looking despite distractions'.

Setup - 6 white bumpers are placed in a perfect line 5 paces apart in a flat field with short cover. All are equally visible.

Strategy - Send the dog for the end bumper on a line that requires him to run by the bumper next to it. The simplest way to run this drill is with 6 parallel lines, each one 45 degrees to the line of white bumpers. By decreasing the angle and increasing the distance, the trainer can make this drill as challenging as he likes.

This is a great 'lining team work' maintenance drill.




