Airing Area

- Please air dogs in the designated area - north of the North East Pond or off the premises.

Cleanliness

- Leave the clubhouse, BBQs, washrooms and grounds cleaner than you found them.

CKC Rules of Conduct Apply to everyone.

- The humane treatment of dogs is absolutely essential.
- Educated and humane pressure for training purposes is allowed.
- Abusive treatment of dogs in any form will not be tolerated.
- Uneducated and excessive pressure is considered abusive.

Conduct:

- Spectators at events should dress in dark or camouflage colors.
- Clubhouse use does not include exclusive use.
- Members are responsible for the conduct of guests, and any damage.
- Smoking is not permitted in the Clubhouse.
- Children under 12, accompanied by an adult, are permitted in the Clubhouse.
- Animals are not allowed in the clubhouse or unrestrained in the camping area.
- BBQing only permitted in the patio area. Users to supply their own consumables.

EQUIPMENT

- Use of club equipment must be approved by the Executive Committee.

FIREARMS

- Practice Firearms Safety. No live ammo. Dispose of spent shells properly.
- Anyone using firearms must have a valid Firearms license.

FIRES

- FIREPIT never unattended if used, drown fires before leaving, If in doubt, do not start one.
- Wood stove before lighting open damper, keep it open until fire is out. Do not use flammables to
- Light the fire, wood only. Before leaving make sure the fire is out, clean out ashes and put them in the metal pail provided.

GARBAGE

- Pick it up when you see it. Dispose of by taking it home.
 - Dispose of training birds properly. Place in bird pit and cover with active lime.

GROUNDS

- Clubs wishing to use the grounds must apply in writing 45 days prior to the date of their event.
- Do not dig or cut vegetation.
- Do not leave ruts, keep vehicles on roads when conditions are wet.
- NO HUNTING PERMITTED

NEIGHBOURS

- RESPECT THEM. Do not block roads, litter or trespass.

REPORTING

- Report any damage or other problems to a member of the Executive in person in person or by telephone or email as soon as possible.

ROADS

- Drive slowly. Park so that other vehicles can pass.

SECURITY

- Lock all doors, windows and gates when you leave.

TRAINING

- Respect each other's training space, do not encroach.
- Do not enter a training area if someone is there until signaled to do so.
- Ensure that all of your training equipment is picked up prior to leaving.
- Maintain control over your dog(s) at all times.
- Amateur Trainers (Member & Non Member):
 1. Active, Active Spousal and Life Members may train on the grounds free of charge,
 2. Junior, Spousal and Honorary members may train on the grounds free of charge provided they train with or are supervised by an Active, Active Spousal or Life Member,
 3. Associate members and Non-members who reside over 150kms from Winnipeg may train on the grounds free of charge provided they train with or are supervised by an Active, Active Spousal or Life member.
- Professional Trainers must apply to the MGDA Secretary for Executive committee approval.
- Handlers (Professional or Amateur):
 - May train on the MGDA grounds free of charge the week prior to and / or the week following an MGDA event in which they are entered.
 - Training must be completed by 4:00 PM each day.

WATER

- Practice water & boating safety. Leave boats high, dry & upside down.

WILDLIFE

- Do not harass in any manner.
