The MGDA Executive Committee reserves the right to preclude any and all use on specific days for grounds maintenance or MGDA sponsored events.

All those who are using MGDA's Clubhouse are expected to acquaint themselves with the MGDA rules, policies and procedures and to comply with them. The following documents relevant to use of the Clubhouse are posted on the MGDA website ([www.manitobagundog.com](http://www.manitobagundog.com)) and on the Clubhouse bulletin board.

- o Failure to comply may cause rights and privileges to be revoked.

The conditions of use are as follows:

Conduct:

- o Members are responsible for the conduct of guests, proper behavior and any damage.
- o Spectators at events should dress in dark or camouflage colours.
- o Smoking is NOT permitted in the Clubhouse.
- o Clubhouse use DOES NOT include exclusive use.
- o Children under 12 years of age are permitted in the Clubhouse only when accompanied by an adult.
- o Animals are NOT allowed in the clubhouse or unrestrained in the camping area.
- o Please air dogs in the designated area - north of the North East Pond or off the premises.
- o Barbecuing is only permitted outside on the patio area.
- o Campfires - Be safety conscious. If in doubt, DON'T START ONE. Be wary of high winds and hot dry conditions. ONLY in FIREPITS or BARBEQUES. NEVER UNATTENDED. DROWN FIRES BEFORE LEAVING.
- o Wood stove before lighting open damper and keep it open until fire is out. Do not use flammables to ignite the fire, wood only. Before leaving make sure the fire is out, clean out ashes and the in the metal pail provided.

Consumables:

- o Members must supply their own consumables including cutlery, paper plates, napkins, dish cloths, soap, paper towels, trash bags, toilet paper, propane, etc.

Cleanliness: LEAVE THE CLUBHOUSE, WASHROOMS AND GROUNDS CLEANER THAN YOU FOUND THEM.

- o Dispose of all garbage (inside and outside clubhouse) by taking it home. DO NOT leave garbage at clubhouse. All trash and debris must be immediately removed from the clubhouse and washrooms to avoid any ant and / or rodent problems in the clubhouse.
  - o Clean all clubhouse areas used including: the grounds, bathrooms, kitchen, sinks, tables, chairs, BBQs, etc.
  - o Pick up garbage when you see it. Be especially conscious of glass.
  - o Sweep / wet mop when there have been spills. Use water only.
  - o Sweep the floor.
  - o Return all chairs, tables, BBQs, etc. to their original location.
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- Leave refrigerator door open.
- Clean BBQs after using.
- Turn OFF BBQ burners and propane tanks.
